2- Superlative Adjectives:

<u>Learning Objective:</u> By the end of this course, learners will be able to identify, form, and use superlative adjectives effectively in speaking and writing.

- 1. **Superlative adjectives** are used to compare three or more people, places, things, or ideas. They show the highest or lowest degree of a quality.
 - Example: Mount Everest is the tallest mountain in the world.

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- o They are often preceded by the definite article "the".
 - Example: *This is the best cake I've ever eaten.*

2. How to Form Superlative Adjectives

- 1. For Short Adjectives (One or Two Syllables):
 - o Add **-est** to the adjective.
 - o Examples:
 - $small \rightarrow smallest$
 - $fast \rightarrow fastest$
 - $tall \rightarrow tall \frac{est}{}$

2.

2-For Long Adjectives (Three or More Syllables):

- Use the most before the adjective.
- o Examples:
 - beautiful \rightarrow the most beautiful
 - $important \rightarrow the most important$
 - interesting → the most interesting
- 3. For Adjectives Ending in -y:
 - o Change -y to -i and add -est.
 - o Examples:
 - happy \rightarrow the happiest
 - $busy \rightarrow the busiest$
- 4. For Adjectives Ending in a Consonant + Vowel + Consonant:
 - Double the final consonant and add **-est**.
 - Examples:
 - $big \rightarrow the \ biggest$
 - $hot \rightarrow the\ hottest$
- 5. Irregular Adjectives:
 - o Some adjectives form their superlative in irregular ways.

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- Examples:
 - $good \rightarrow the best$

- $bad \rightarrow the \ worst$
- $far \rightarrow the farthest/the furthest$

**Using Superlative Adjectives

- 1. To Compare Three or More Nouns:
 - the + superlative adjective + [noun]
 - o Examples:
 - This is the tallest building in the city.
 - *She is the most talented singer in the group*.

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2. Superlative with Negative Comparisons:

Use "the least" for the lowest degree.

- Examples:
 - This is the least expensive item in the store.
 - He is the least experienced player on the team.

**Common Errors to Avoid

1. Double Superlatives:

o Incorrect: This is the most tallest tree.

o Correct: This is the tallest tree.

2. Omitting "The":

o Incorrect: She is fastest runner.

o Correct: She is the fastest runner.

**Examples of Superlative Adjectives in Sentences

Adjective	Superlative	Example	
small	the smallest	This is the smallest box on the shelf.	
happy	the happiest	She is the happiest person I know.	
expensive	the most expensive	This is the most expensive car in the lot.	
bad	the worst	That was the worst movie I've ever seen.	
good	the best	He is the best player in the team.
