Introduction to Legal English

1. What is Legal English?

Definition:

Legal English is the type or style of language used by legal professionals (judges, lawyers, legislators) and in legal documents (contracts, laws, court decisions).

2. Characteristics of Legal English:

- **Formal tone**: Legal English avoids slang and casual expressions.
- **Precise vocabulary**: Each word has a specific legal meaning.
- **Passive voice**: Often used to focus on the action, not the person.
- **Latin phrases**: Some traditional terms are taken from Latin (e.g., *habeas corpus*, *pro bono*).
- **Long sentences**: Legal documents often use complex sentence structures.

ما هي الإنجليزية القانونية؟

الإنجليزية القانونية هي اللغة أو الأسلوب الذي يستخدمه المتخصصون في المجال القانوني مثل القضاة، المحامون، والمشرّعون، وتُستعمل أيضًا في الوثائق القانو نية كالعقود، القوانين، والأحكام القضائية.

خصائص الانجليزية القانونية:

- تتجنّب الإنجليزية القانونية استخدام العبارات العامية أو التعبيرات غير الرسمية.

 - لكلُّ كلمة معنى قانوني محدد وواضح.
 - استخدام المبني للمجهول: يُستخدم المبني للمجهول: يُستخدم بكثرة للتركيز على الفعل القانوني بدلًا من الشخص القائم به.

 - تتضمن بعض المصطلحات التقليدية المأخوذة من اللغة اللاتينية
- تميل النصوص القانونية إلى استخدام تراكيب لغوية طويلة ومعقّدة لزيادة الدقة والشمول.

Example:

- General English: "You must pay the money."
- Legal English: "The payment shall be made by the party within thirty days."

3. Basic Legal Vocabulary

Word	Meaning	Example
Law	A system of rules created by the government	The law protects people's rights.
Court	A place where legal cases are decided	The court decided he was not guilty.
Judge	The official who controls the courtroom	The judge gave the final decision.
Lawyer	A person who gives legal advice or defends someone	I spoke to a lawyer about my case.
Right	A freedom or entitlement given by law	You have the right to remain silent.
Duty	A legal or moral obligation	It is your duty to obey the law.
Case	A legal dispute brought to a court	The case was about a land dispute.
Crime	An act that breaks the law	Theft is a crime.

5. Legal Expressions and Their Meanings:

1. "According to the law..."

→ This means based on what the law says or as stated in the legal rules.

Example: "According to the law, children must attend school until a certain age."

2. "It is the duty of the citizen to..."

→ This means the citizen is legally or morally required to do something.

Example: "It is the duty of the citizen to pay taxes."

3. "This action is considered a crime under the law."

→ This means the law defines this behavior as illegal or criminal.

Example: "Stealing is considered a crime under the law."

4. "The judge ruled in favor of..."

→ This means the judge made a decision that supports one side in a legal case.

Example: "The judge ruled in favor of the plaintiff."
